



QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER WHEN CHOOSING YOUR WEDDING VENUE

How long can a provisional booking be held for, and will you be contacted prior to a provisional booking being released?

Is there over-night accommodation for guests? Will you be offered a discounted rate and how straight forward is the reservation process for your guests?

How will your guests travel from the ceremony venue to the reception?

What does the venue hire include? Check for hidden extras such as VAT, service charges, insurance and furniture hire.

How efficient are the venue's heating or cooling systems?

Is there a choice of caterers, what is their approach to menu tastings?

Are you able to bring in your own caterer?

What kitchen facilities are available?

Will there be other weddings taking place on the same day?

How is this managed?

Can you move furniture in the venue or bring in your furniture?

Are candles and fireworks allowed?

Is red wine allowed?

Is dancing permitted?

Are there any restrictions in bringing in your own suppliers for flowers, entertainment and production?

What are the license restrictions for the venue both in terms of entertainment and the service of alcohol? Note license restrictions vary within venues, such as no amplified music outside.

What toilet/baby changing facilities are available? Some unique venues have 'unique facilities' so always worth a check!

What are the terms and conditions of hire?

What venue staff are available on the day and throughout the evening?

When can you access the venue to set up?

Do your suppliers have to clear the venue on the same evening or can they return the next morning?
